PEDESTRIAN BULB

Bulb-outs are curb extension that extend the sidewalk to narrow the roadway and provide additional pedestrian space at key locations. They can shorten the crossing distance, increase pedestrian visibility, slow turning vehicles, and visually narrow the roadway. 




LOCATIONS FOR IMPROVEMENTS
