[Approving General Plan Amendments Related to the Glen Park Area Plan.]

Ordinance amending the San Francisco General Plan by adding the Glen Park Area Plan; and making findings, including environmental findings and findings of consistency with the General Plan and the Priority Policies of Planning Code Section 101.1.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Findings.

- A. Section 4.105 of the Charter of the City and County of San Francisco provides that the Planning Commission shall periodically recommend to the Board of Supervisors, for approval or rejection, proposed amendments to the General Plan.
- B. On _______, the Board of Supervisors received from the Planning

 Department the proposed General Plan amendments, including the addition of the "Glen Park

 Community Plan" or "Glen Park Area Plan," and revisions to other Elements of the General

 Plan, as well as an update of the Land Use Index. These amendments are on file with the

 Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. ______ and are incorporated herein by

 reference.
- C. Section 4.105 of the City Charter further provides that if the Board of Supervisors fails to Act within 90 days of receipt of the proposed the Glen Park Area Plan amendments, then the proposed amendments shall be deemed approved.
- D. San Francisco Planning Code Section 340 provides that the Planning Commission may initiate an amendment to the General Plan by a resolution of intention,

opportunities and interagency coordination the City must pursue to implement the Glen Park Area Plan. The Glen Park Area Plan amendments is an action proposed by the Planning Department that is within the scope of the Project evaluated in the Final EIR.

- Η. At the same hearing during which the Planning Commission certified the Final EIR, the Planning Commission adopted CEQA Findings with respect to the approval of the proposed Glen Park Area Plan amendments in Motion _____ and adopted the Glen Park Area Plan amendments in Resolution ______, finding in accordance with Planning Code Section 340 that the public necessity, convenience and general welfare required the proposed amendments. The letter from the Planning Department transmitting the proposed Glen Park Area Plan amendments to the Board of Supervisors, the Final EIR and supplemental material described above, the CEQA Findings adopted by the Planning Commission with respect to the approval of the Glen Park Area Plan amendments, including a mitigation monitoring and reporting program and a statement of overriding considerations, the Glen Park Area Plan amendments and the Resolution approving the Glen Park Area Plan Amendments are on file with the Clerk of the Board in File No._____. These and any and all other documents referenced in this Ordinance have been made available to the Board of Supervisors and may be found in either the files of the Planning Department, as the custodian of records, at 1650 Mission Street in San Francisco, or in File No. ______ with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors at 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, San Francisco and are incorporated herein by reference.
- I. The Board of Supervisors has reviewed and considered the Final EIR and the environmental documents on file referred to herein. The Board of Supervisors has reviewed and considered the CEQA Findings adopted by the Planning Commission in support of the approval of the Glen Park Area Plan amendments, and hereby adopts as its own and

incorporates the CEQA Findings contained in Planning Commission Motion No. ______ by reference as though such findings were fully set forth in this Ordinance.

- J. The Board of Supervisors endorses the implementation of the mitigation measures identified in the Planning Commission's CEQA Findings including those for implementation by other City Departments and recommends for adoption those mitigation measures that are enforceable by agencies other than City agencies, all as set forth in the CEQA Findings, including the mitigation monitoring and reporting program contained in the referenced CEQA Findings.
- K. The Board of Supervisors finds that no substantial changes have occurred in the Project proposed for approval under this Ordinance that will require revisions in the Final EIR due to the involvement of new significant environmental effects or a substantial increase in the severity of previously identified significant effects, no substantial changes have occurred with respect to the circumstances under which the Project proposed for approval under the Ordinance are undertaken which will require major revisions to the Final EIR due to the involvement of new environmental effects or a substantial increase in the severity of effects identified in the Final EIR and no new information of substantial importance to the Project as proposed for approval in the Ordinance has become available which indicates that (1) the Project will have significant effects not discussed in the Final EIR, (2) significant environmental effects will be substantially more severe, (3) mitigation measure or alternatives found not feasible which would reduce one or more significant effects have become feasible or (4) mitigation measures or alternatives which are considerably different from those in the Final EIR would substantially reduce one or more significant effects on the environment.
- M. The Board of Supervisors finds, pursuant to Planning Code Section 340, that the Glen Park Area Plan amendments set forth in the documents on file with the Clerk of the Board in File No. ______ will serve the public necessity, convenience and

3	N. The Board of Supervisors finds that the Glen Park Area Plan amendments are,
4	on balance, in conformity with the General Plan, as it is amended by this Ordinance, and the
5	eight priority policies of Planning Code Section 101.1 for the reasons set forth in Planning
6	Commission Resolution No The Board hereby adopts the findings set forth in
7	Planning Commission Resolution No
8	Section 2. The Board of Supervisors hereby approves the proposed Glen Park Area
9	Plan amendments, an amendment to the General Plan, as recommended to the Board of
10	Supervisors by the Planning Commission in Resolution No, and directs the
11	Planning Department to update the General Plan's Land Use Index to reflect these
12	amendments. Said amendments, including General Plan map amendments, are on file with
13	the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No and are incorporated herein
14	by reference.
15	Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days from the
16	date of passage.
