

STREETSCAPE DESIGN DEVELOPMENT

In July, the SFMTA presented a preferred alternative for the roadway design for Polk Street. The next phase of the project is the development of a streetscape design. The goal of the Streetscape Design Development phase is to develop a streetscape design that creates a thriving and active corridor, enhances the pedestrian experience, compliments bicycle and transit mobility, and supports commercial activity.

GOALS OF THE WORKING GROUP

- » Review existing land use and streetscape conditions
- » Obtain preliminary feedback and ideas about streetscape elements
- » Understand how the streetscape design and the roadway design will compliment each other

- » Identify locations along the corridor to enhance existing elements and prioritize locations for improvements

Session #2: Tuesday, October 22, 2013 (City Hall Room 201, 4-6pm)

- » Review what we heard at Session #1
- » Provide feedback on specific streetscape elements that might work well for Polk Street (based on what we heard at Session #1)


