The Way It Was:

A Restaurant was permitted to obtain a license type 47 or 49 in the Union Street NCD so long as it operated as a bona fide eating establishment (at least 51% of their gross receipts come from the sale of food). Limited-Restaurants were permitted as of right in the Union Street NCD.

The Way It Is Now:

No new 47 or 49 liquor licenses are permitted in the Union Street NCD, but existing licenses can be transferred within the District to other Restaurants, and Limited-Restaurants now require conditional use authorization.
