The Way It Was:

Voluntarily adding car-share spaces above what is required in addition to maxing out the allowable parking for private automobiles was not permitted by the Planning Code.

The Way It Is Now:

Project sponsors can voluntarily add additional car share spaces even if they have maxed out the total number of principally permitted parking spaces. The number of permitted optional spaces is outlined the following chart:

Car share spaces that existed on a "soft site" for a year or more can be retained when that site is developed, even if the number of spaces exceeds the amount permitted in the chart above.

Additional car share spaces cannot be provided if the project sponsor received Conditional Use authorization for parking above the maximum number of permitted parking spaces.
