The Way It Was:

The Planning Code requires various fees for permits the Planning Department issues. The following four fees were included, among others, in the list of fees: (1) a processing fee of \$53 in order to set up a phased payment plan for a collection of fees for a project whose work is projected to span more than one fiscal year; (2) a \$436 non-refundable processing fee when applications are withdrawn or cancelled prior to a public hearing; (3) a \$250 initial fee in order to prepare certain kinds of information or reports; and (4) a fee of \$237 to reactivate an application that the Zoning Administrator has deemed withdrawn due to inactivity and passage of time.

The Way It Is Now:

The four fees have been eliminated and are no longer charged.
