

New Planning Code Summary: Medical Service Use - Sacramento Street Neighborhood Commercial District

The proposed Ordinance amended the Planning Code to provide that in the Sacramento Street Neighborhood Commercial District a Medical Service use, whether Principal or Accessory, requires Conditional Use authorization on the ground story, and is principally permitted above the ground story.

The Way It Was:

- 1. Within the Sacramento NCD, new Medical Service uses were prohibited, except that a Business or Professional Service use was allowed to convert to a Medical Service use on the first story or below if no residential use or active street frontage was lost.
- 2. Medical Service was allowed as an Accessory Use within all Neighborhood Commercial Districts (NCDs).

The Way It Is Now:

- 1. Medical Service uses on the ground floor and below require CU authorization, and are principally permitted on the second floor and above.
- 2. Medical Service as an Accessory Use would require Conditional Use authorization on the ground floor or below.
