On January 26, 2012, the I	Planning Commission co	nducted a Discretionary	Review hearing to c	onsider the
following project:				

183 Brewster Street - Request for Discretionary Review for Building Permit Application No. 2006.09.25. 3193 proposing to construct a new multi-story, single-family dwelling on a down-sloping lot, in a RH-1 (Residential, House, One-Family) District and a 40-X Height and Bulk District, and within the Bernal Heights Special Use District.

ACTION

The Commission determined that no modifications to the project were necessary and they instructed staff to approve the project per plans marked Exhibit A on file with the Planning Department.

FINDINGS

The reasons the Commission took the action described above include:

The Project site provided a limited opportunity for development. The proposal appropriately responded to the site's limitations and met the strict requirements of the Bernal Heights Special Use District, resulting in no extraordinary or exceptional circumstances in the case. The proposal complies with the Planning Code, the General Plan, and conforms to the Residential Design Guidelines.
