Board of Supervisors Approved First Residential Landmark District Since 2003

On June 4, 2013, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors joined the Planning and Historic Preservation Commissions in unanimously approving the landmark district status of the residential neighborhood adjacent to Duboce Park as a local landmark district, citing its architectural character and historical significance. The landmark district includes 87 residential buildings and three distinctive mid-block park entrances.

The Planning Department would like to thank Supervisor Wiener and the Duboce Triangle Neighborhood Association for their involvement in obtaining this designation.

The legislation has been forwarded to Mayor Edwin Lee for approval of final landmark district designation.
