City Calls for Proposals for New Parklets

In addition, the city has developed the <u>San Francisco Parklet Manual</u>, a comprehensive overview of the goals, policies, procedures and guidelines for creating a parklet in San Francisco.

To help interested parties complete the application process, the City hosted an open house on March 5.
