Preservation Element of the General Plan Update

The Planning Department is excited to be resuming work on the Preservation Element after a stall due to budget cuts in 2009. The document's objectives and policies address the importance of preserving historic resources and their essential role in maintaining the character of San Francisco. Once approved, the Preservation Element will become part of the City's General Plan.

The department plans to complete a final draft of the Preservation Element by the end of 2014. In order to accomplish this goal, the Draft Preservation Element will be presented through a series of public hearings to the Planning Commission and the Historic Preservation Commission for review and comment. In addition to the public hearings, the department will host an open house providing an opportunity for the public to learn more and provide feedback on the document.
