On January 21, 2010 (continued from December 17, 2009), the Planning Commission conducted a Discretionary Review hearing to consider the following project:

<u>1376 FLORIDA STREET</u> - west side between 25<sup>th</sup> Street and 26<sup>th</sup> Street; Lot 014 in Assessor's Block 4272 - **Request for Discretionary Review** of Building Permit Application No. 2009.03.27.4981, proposing to construct a vertical addition, horizontal side and rear additions, install a garage, and rehabilitate the façade of the existing two-story over basement, single-family residence, resulting in two dwelling units, in an RH-2 (Residential House, Two-Family) District and a 40-X Height and Bulk Designation.

## **ACTION**

The Commission determined that no modifications to the project were necessary and they instructed staff to approve the project per plans marked Exhibit A on file with the Planning Department.

## **FINDINGS**
