On July 15, 2010, the Planning Commission conducted a Discretionary Review hearing to consider the following project:

3131 MISSION STREET – east side between Cesar Chavez Street and Precita Avenue; Lot 048 in Assessor’s Block 5501 – Mandatory Discretionary Review of Building Permit Application No. 2010.01.13.4660, proposing conversion of a two bedroom dwelling to a neighborhood serving dental office in an NC-3 (Moderate Scale Neighborhood Commercial) District and a 50-X Height and Bulk District.

ACTION

The Commission did not take Discretionary Review and approved the conversion of the existing dwelling unit to a neighborhood serving dental office, per plans marked Exhibit A on file with the Planning Department.

FINDINGS

The reasons the Commission took the action described above include:
