On June 10, 2010, the Planning Commission conducted a Discretionary Review hearing to consider the following project. At the June 10, 2010 hearing, the Planning Commission continued the item to July 15, 2010 at the request of the project sponsor.

<u>2016 CHESTNUT STREET</u> (at the northwest corner of Fillmore Street) – north side, Lot 023 in Assessor's Block 0467A, proposing to locate two T-Mobile omi-directional antennas of approximately 1.5" in diameter and 24" in height on architectural columns on the north and west sides of the subject building at approximately 63' above grade within an Neighborhood Commercial – Small Scale District (NC-2) and 40-X Height and Bulk District.

## **ACTION**

The Commission determined that no modifications to the project were necessary and they instructed staff to approve the project per plans marked Exhibit A on file with the Planning Department.

## **FINDINGS**
