On July 10, 2008, the Planning Commission conducted a Discretionary Review hearing to consider the following project:

850 – 29th AVENUE - east side between Fulton and Cabrillo Streets; Lot 008M in Assessor's Block 1671- Mandatory Discretionary Review, under the Planning Commission's policy requiring review of residential demolitions, of Demolition Permit Application No. 2006.11.15.7797 proposing to demolish a two-story, single-family building and replace it with a three-story, two-family building in an RH-2 (Residential, House, 2-Family) District and a 40-X Height and Bulk District.

ACTION

The Commission determined that no modifications to the project were necessary and they instructed staff to approve the project as revised per plans marked Exhibit A on file with the Planning Department.

FINDINGS

The reasons the Commission took the action described above include:
