

# Near Term Construction Project PROJECT BOUNDARY:

Manor to Phelan Avenue

### **TIMELINE:**

- Planning: March 2014 to July 2014:
  - Site Walk: March 8, 2014
  - Public Workshop #1: March 12, 2014
  - Public Workshop #2: May 2014
  - Public Workshop #3: July 2014
- Construction Drawings Begin: Summer 2014
- Construction: 2015

## **Longer Term Design Project**

### **PROJECT BOUNDARY:**

Phelan Avenue to San Jose Avenue

### **FUNDING:**

 Federal transportation funds for planning in Priority Development Areas (PDAs)

### TIMELINE:

- Planning: January 2014 to August 2015
  - Existing Conditions Analysis
  - Develop Design Options
  - Detailed Design, Cost Estimate and Phasing Plan



### **Invest in Neighborhoods - Ocean Avenue Initiatives**

- 5 SF Shines façade improvement applications submitted with more on the way
- RFP proposal submitted by OAA for neighborhood improvement projects
- OAA Business Committee established and will begin meeting regularly
  - Vacancy tracking
  - Business recruitment
  - Business strengthening
- OAA Street Life Committee meets the 2<sup>nd</sup>
   Wednesday of every month

### **Balboa Park Circulation Study**

- Draft Final Report completed April 2014.
  - Supported by Balboa Park CAC
  - To be adopted by TA Board in June
- Intend to move forward with scoping the next steps for two elements of the recommended alternative:
  - Realignment of the SB I-280 off-ramp to Ocean Ave
  - Closure of the NB I-280 on-ramp from Geneva Ave
- Project implementation potentially as early as 2017

### **Balboa Park Eastside Connection, BART**

- Consists of glazed headhouse, concourse deck, pedestrian bridge, East side walkway, Muni platform, and wayfinding.
- Add alternatives include clerestory glazing, wall panel treatments, enhanced interior lighting, stainless steel guardrails.
- Complete Final Design soon
- Advertise Fall 2014
- Construction begins Late 2014



# Near Term Construction Project: Design Options


## **Near Term Construction Project: Manor to Phelan**

- 5. Bike improvements/racks








# Longer Term Design: Phelan to San Jose

#### What we heard: Overall


- Like new Whole Foods development, Beep sign, Ingleside Presbyterian Church, Java on Ocean, Balboa Park

- Upgrade timing to prioritize transit





When you walk from the Balboa Park Station to the Ocean Avenue Commercial Corridor or to City College, which street do you generally choose?








