Project History: Guerrero Park was originally installed in 2009 as a temporary traffic calming effort at the intersection of Guerrero St and San Jose Ave. In collaboration with the City, California Pacific Medical Center (CPMC) has committed to installing permanent improvements and establish the site as a southern gateway to the Mission Neighborhood.
