



- 5. **Increase economic security** by strengthening educational and economic pathways and job opportunities for low to moderate income individuals and families, especially those without a college education.

Strategies Under Consideration

Through working groups we have developed an extensive list of possible strategies for community stabilization under the following categories:

- **Tenant Protections & housing access:** keep people in their homes and increase access to housing, including displaced seniors and undocumented without paths to permanent housing.
- **Housing Preservation:** retain existing affordable housing stock, including SROs
- **Housing Production:** build new affordable housing
- **Economic Development:** keep jobs, business, artists & nonprofits in the neighborhood
- **Funding Resources:** explore and add funding sources
- **Community Planning:** inform and engage the community early and often in key policies and projects.
- **Homelessness:** increase housing options and housing protections for homeless individuals.
