

Pavement to Parks: Transforming Persia Triangle

The Persia Triangle is fondly known as the "Heart of the Excelsior" as it is centrally located at the intersection of Mission Street, Ocean Avenue and Persia Avenue.

The temporary plaza is a Pavement to Parks installation for the community to enjoy from September 2014 to March 2015. The plaza is the first step of a larger beautification effort that will take place in 2015 in the Heart of the Excelsior.

In March 2015, DPW will install new wider sidewalks to replace the temporary installation; PUC will install six new pedestrian lighting fixtures around the Triangle and a community kiosk will be installed by Architecture for Humanity as a place for the community to share ideas and resources.

Other projects happening in 2015 will be an art installation on the fence along the Triangle, a new bench project designed and built by Youth Arts Exchange, a new mural and a food kiosk at the corner of Mission Street and Ocean Avenue.
