# Market / Octavia Survey

- Part of Market / Octavia Area Plan
  - Used for the development of policies and objectives for area plans
- Survey of over 1,500 buildings
  - Eligible historic districts and individual properties identified
- Historic Preservation Commission adopted survey findings in 2009

### **Article 10 Permit Review Process**

- Designation limited to exteriors in order to Protect significant features
- Ordinary maintenance and repair process will continue as existing
- Exterior alterations:
  "The Standards"
- Changes will be *either* a staff-reviewed
   Administrative "C of A" (Certificate of Appropriateness)...
- or, a HPC hearing for the C of A in the case of major construction or major alterations
