

LGBTQ CULTURAL HERITAGE STRATEGY WORKING GROUP

San Francisco Planning, together with the Office of Economic and Workforce Development (OEWD) and the San Francisco Entertainment Commission, has begun developing a Citywide LGBTQ Cultural Heritage Strategy to preserve and promote LGBTQ cultural heritage in San Francisco. Specifically, it will provide a comprehensive implementation plan to safeguard LGBTQ cultural heritage through a series of identified projects, procedures, programs or techniques.

The Working Group will provide input in this process including but not limited to:

- Guiding the strategy to one that is reflective and inclusive of the community, and
- Engaging with community members on a number of occasions to both educate them on the effort as well as collect ideas and input.

The Group will meet approximately once a month for approximately six months, starting in January 2017.

The Group will consist of representatives from each of the following neighborhoods: SoMa, Tenderloin, Mission, Polk Street, North Beach and Castro.

This scope of this study may be expanded to a second phase, which will be determined in the following months in coordination with the Working Group.
