## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The proposal is for the installation of 50 broadcast and reception antennas, microwave dishes and camera mounts at various levels on the tower; replacement and relocation of one existing auxiliary radio antenna to a higher level on the tower; addition of one ground-level approximately 30-foot wide satellite dish; and road, retaining wall, stairway, driveway, and erosion control improvements; within an RH-1 (Residential - House, One Family) Zoning District and a 40-X Height and Bulk District.

#### HEARING INFORMATION

Persons who are unable to attend the public hearing may submit written comments regarding this application to the Planner listed on the front of this notice, Planning Department, 1650 Mission Street, Suite 400, San Francisco, CA 94103, by 5:00 pm the day before the hearing. These comments will be made a part of the official public record and will be brought to the attention of the person or persons conducting the public hearing.

Comments that cannot be delivered by 5:00 pm the day before the hearing may be taken directly to the hearing at the location listed on the front of this notice. Comments received at 1650 Mission Street after the deadline will be placed in the project file, but may not be brought to the attention of the Planning Commission at the public hearing.

#### BUILDING PERMIT APPLICATION INFORMATION

Pursuant to Planning Code Section 311, the Building Permit Application for this proposal may also be subject to a 30day notification of property owners and residents within 150-feet of the subject property. **This notice covers the Section 311 notification requirements, if required.** 

#### APPEAL INFORMATION

An appeal of the approval (or denial) of a **building permit application** by the Planning Commission may be made to the **Board of Appeals within 15 calendar days** after the building permit is issued (or denied) by the Director of the Department of Building Inspection. Appeals must be submitted in person at the Board's office at 1650 Mission Street, 3rd Floor, Room 304. Pursuant to California Government Code Section 65009, if you challenge, in court, the decision of an entitlement or permit, the issues raised shall be limited to those raised in the public hearing or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission prior to, or at, the public hearing.
